The Government's €500 million Disruptive Technologies Innovation Fund (DTIF) is open for applications.

Administered by Enterprise Ireland on behalf of the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment, the Fund aims to encourage collaborations between industry and the research sector for the development and commercialisation of ground-breaking technologies.

DTIF funds collaborations to deliver disruptive technology innovations that:

- Can alter markets.
- Can alter the way business operates.
- Involves a new product or the emergence of a new business model.

DTIF is for SMEs (including High Potential Start Ups), large enterprises, multinational corporations and research performing organisations based in Ireland.

Project partners must be clients of Enterprise Ireland, IDA Ireland or Údarás na Gaeltachta or eligible Research Performing Organisations.

Across the first six DTIF calls to date, 104 collaborative projects with 393 partners were approved for funding of €371 million.

This directory provides statistics on the DTIF programme to date and briefly captures the range of projects across ICT, Health & Wellbeing, Food, Innovation in Business Services, Manufacturing & Materials, and Energy, Climate Action & Sustainability.

DTIF Call 7 was launched in May 2024 and will fund many more exciting collaborations that will promote the use of new and emerging technologies.






Number of Collaborating Partners per Project (Calls 1-6)




Partner Types in DTIF Projects (Calls 1-6)




Lead Partner Types in DTIF Projects (Calls 1-6)



Projects by Sector (Calls 1-6)




Spend Commitment across sectors (calls 1-6)
