It is expected that the transposition deadline of 05 April 2024 will be met.		
2. Directive (EU) 2022/2041 of 19 October 2022 on adequate minimum wages in the European Union.	15/11/24 <u>Unit:</u> Labour Market and Skills Unit.	Assessment has begun on transposition requirements. It is expected that the transposition deadline of 15 November 2024 will be met.

Draft instructions have issued to the Office of Parliamentary Counsel for settlement. It is expected that the transposition deadline of the 6 July 2024 will be met.

Directive (EU) 2023/7020 amending Directive 2013/34/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the adjustments of the size criteria for micro, small, medium-sized and large undertakings or groups.	17/10/2024 <u>Unit:</u> Company Law – Audit & Accounting, Policy & Legislation Unit.	Assessment has begun on the transposition requirements. The Commission will observe a two-month period of scrutiny for the Parliament and Council and once concluded will publish the delegated directive in the official journal. Member States will have 12 months from the date of entry into force to transpose the requirements into national legislation.
