





Strategic Approach to Town Centres

> Once-off and isolated projects prone to failure

- Poor/limited support base
- Impacts often uncertain/unclear
- Proposals for development and interventions need to be anchored in a wider development strategy
- Integrated measures to maximise impact and visibly
- Consistent with 'Place-based' approach




Focus on Investment in Public Realm and Amenities





Town & Village Renewal Scheme

- Projects to develop town/village centre plazas, public outdoor dining spaces
- Upgrading and enhancement of shopfronts and street facades
- Projects bringing vacant & derelict buildings/sites back into use
